LAKEWOLD GARDENS MUSIC SERVICE AGREEMENT

Renter may not use any music service without said Agreement signed by both parties, nor may they provide their own music unless approved by Lakewold Gardens.

It is understood that the following conditions MUST be met in order for a MUSICIAN to perform at Lakewold Gardens:

- 1. Amplified music (ceremony excluded) must be in the Wagner House. Speakers or amplified sound of any kind is not allowed outside or directed towards the outdoors with exterior doors open.
- 2. No amplified sound or noise may ever reach a decibel level over 60dBA, as stated in the Environmental Noise Regulation WAC 173-60-040 at a distance of 10 feet from any noise or music source. The noise and sound levels may be monitored with a decibel meter during an event.
- 3. The piano may be moved by Lakewold Gardens staff only and nothing is to be placed on top of piano.
- 4. Music Service Provider is responsible for providing electrical adaptors and extension cords. No cords can be taped on walls or doorway floors, nor demonstrate a hazard to guests.
- 5. Music Service Providers MUST NOT consume any alcohol or drugs while on Lakewold Gardens' premises. This will be strictly enforced and under no circumstances will it be tolerated.
- 6. Music must end no later than 10:00 pm.
- 7. Music Service Provider will be responsible for leaving Lakewold Gardens and the Wagner House in like condition, as it was when Music Service Provider arrived.
- 8. Lakewold Gardens is not responsible for lost or damaged property.

NOT ABIDING BY THESE CONDITIONS MAY CONSTITUTE TERMINATION OF MUSIC IMMEDIATELY.

Drop Off/Set Up: Due to open hours and other booked events at Lakewold Gardens, musician for this event may not arrive until 3:00 pm on event date. Musician may begin set up in the Living Room/Dining Room/Verandah no earlier than 3:00pm. Musician may begin set up of all other areas no earlier than 3:30pm. **PLEASE NOTE:** All deliveries and equipment must be brought to the back of the Wagner House.

Clean Up: It is the responsibility of the RENTER to see that the Music Service Provider removes all equipment by 10:30 pm. Equipment must be removed through the back of the Wagner House.
