October.

Key Responsibilities: Welcoming guests to Lakewold: This volunteer opportunity includes orienting visitors for

their self-guided tours and collecting admissions payment. The person in this position helps out in the garden shop and nursery, assisting with plant, garden tools and gift sales using cash register as well as behind the scenes inventory and plant care. Another aspect of the position is acquiring and recording information from visitors for tourist tracking. If you enjoy working with the public, this is a great volunteer opportunity.

Qualifications: Must enjoy and perform excellent customer service. Must be willing to learn simple

payment transactions. Knowledge of basic Lakewold Garden's history, prized plants,

offerings, and general gardening know-how is beneficial.

Time Commitment: Shifts are for 3 hours, with an ongoing commitment of two shifts each month.

Availability for one shift is required during Lakewold's MayFest and Beautiful Tables

events.

Training/Support

Provided: Two 2 ½ hour training sessions are provided for volunteers to attain status as a Certified

Garden Shop Volunteer. Trainings are offered in February and March, and include familiarization with the grounds, admissions, visitor services, using cash register for

garden shop sales, procedures, inventory and plant maintenance.

Benefits: An individual membership is given after completion of 15 volunteer hours, annually,

including a 10% discount in the Garden Shop and nursery. An annual Picnic with Purpose

is held in August to recognize the efforts of volunteers.
