1. We ask you to pre-register for all workshops; drop-ins will be allowed ONLY if space permits (friends or siblings, see #4, below). All parents/guardians must leave a cell phone or home number where they can be reached in case of an emergency during the workshop.
2. Each workshop is limited to 15 children. Families will be contacted in advance to confirm attendance. Wait list is limited to five, who will be contacted if space becomes available.
3. Lakewold will accept donations or pay what you can. There is no set fee to attend.
4. Children must be between ages 7 and 12, entering grades 2 - 6 in Fall, 2016.
5. Workshops begin promptly at 10:00am and last until 12:30pm. Each workshop consists of a dedicated lesson, outdoor activity\*/snack break, and a hands-on project related to lesson.
